END OF THE HOLY YEAR

The Holy Year draws to a close around the world on Christmas Day (although it finishes in Rome on the Feast of the Epiphany) and so a visit to St Mary's church still entitles you to a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions until then. Fittingly, this Holy Year both begins and ends with the feast of the Incarnation, reminding us that all renewal, reconciliation and hope find their source in Christ made flesh. Christmas, which brings the Jubilee Year to its close, marks the 2025th anniversary of the birth of Christ.

More than a calculation, it is a confession of faith, in the Incarnation, God entered human history and remains with us. As the Holy Year ends where it began, we return to its heart, "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us."
